### IV. Field-Target Shooting Saxonia Open Marienberg/Sa. 2016

The competition will take place on May 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>st</sup> 2016 at the military training area of the „Panzergrenadier Batallion 371, Marienberger Jäger“. It is located at the beautiful countryside of the „Erzgebirge“ near the city of Marienberg.

The shooting area is located due west of the road „B174“ from Chemnitz to Chomotov (CZ), opposite the junction „Gelobtland“. The coordinates are +50° 36' 30.07", +13° 9' 42.30"

There are many hotels and other accommodation near the shooting site. But nevertheless please book in time.

In the attached document you'll find some information, pictures and a map (Sorry, only German).

Late arrival can not be regarded.

1. The competition will follow the rules of the BDS.
2. There are **5** different categories of guns:  
Class 1 – PCP, max.  $E_0=16.3$  J (FAC), range from 9 m to 50 m  
Class 2 – Springer, max.  $E_0=16.3$  J (FAC), range from 9 m to 50 m  
Class 3 – PCP, max.  $E_0=7.5$  J, range from 9 m to 25 m  
Class 4 – Springer, max.  $E_0=7.5$  J, range from 9 m to 25 m  
Class 5 – Recoilless springer, max.  $E_0=7.5$  J, range from 9 m to 25 m
3. Please keep the area clean.
4. Vehicles must be parked on the marked places and must not block the roads
5. Smoking is only permitted in the areas specifically designated for such purposes.
6. If there are military police, rambler or hunter, please inform the service team.
7. This is a big area with a high population of wildlife so take care and keep calm if you spot a boar, deer or any other animals.
8. Toilets are at the service point.

Rifles may be imported into Germany without further permission if the owner possesses an European Firearms Passport (EFP) in which his weapon(s) is/are registered (if in you have in your country a Firearms Certificate, FAC, you have it also to carry with you, also when you made a bundled application as indicated later). All other foreign shooters need essentially a firearm import permission which is issued by the local firearms regulatory authority. The fee is € 20,- including mailing costs. One applicant can import up to 6 rifles per permis-

sion. Therefore, it is wise when an RGB bundles its applications so save money. The applications will only be issued after the competition entrance fee plus € 25.- is paid by bank transfer. In all cases you need an official invitation of BDS which will be sent to the applicant or the EFP holder after payment. Silencers, even for air rifles with a muzzle energy of more than 7.5 J are virtually prohibited in Germany!

The competition consists of a course with 25 lanes at both competition days with 50 shots each on 50 targets at unknown distance in a wooden area.
